Dr. Muhammad K. Hasan is the Director of Advanced Endoscopy Fellowship Program at Center for Interventional Endoscopy. He received his medical degree from Allama Iqbal Medical College Lahore, Pakistan. He is board certified in gastroenterology and internal medicine.

Dr Hasan completed his residency at the University of Oklahoma, Oklahoma City where he also served as a Chief Medical Resident for a year. After that, he completed his gastroenterology fellowship training in 2008 at the same institution. Then, Dr Hasan went to Mayo Clinic Jacksonville and completed training in advanced endoscopy and endoscopic ultrasound (EUS).
