# Prechtl's General Movement Assessment: Basic Course

# **COURSE INFORMATION**

The AdventHealth Orlando Sports Med & Rehab is proud to offer the basic general movement assessment course. Research conducted in the last 20 years has shown the qualitative assessment of spontaneous movement in the fetus, newborn, and young infant is an early and reliable indicator for diagnosis and prognosis of neurological disorders. Compelling evidence is now available that qualitative assessment of General Movements —a specific type of spontaneous movement—under the age of five months is the best predictor of cerebral palsy. This course fulfills the standards specified by the Generalized Movement Trust (www.general-movements-trust.info). The course will consist of lessons, demonstration, and discussion of video-recordings. Lectures will alternate with exercises in small groups with videos prepared by the tutors.

Participants will be required to take a final test at the end of the course to receive a certificate of reliability in this method of assessment.

## **COURSE OBJECTIVES**

- Assess typically developing infants using the General Movement Assessment.
- Assess infants with brain lesions using the General Movement Assessment.
- Describe how to incorporate the General Movement Assessment technique into their clinical and research practices.
- Distinguish between typical and atypical general movements in developing infants using the General Movement Assessment.
